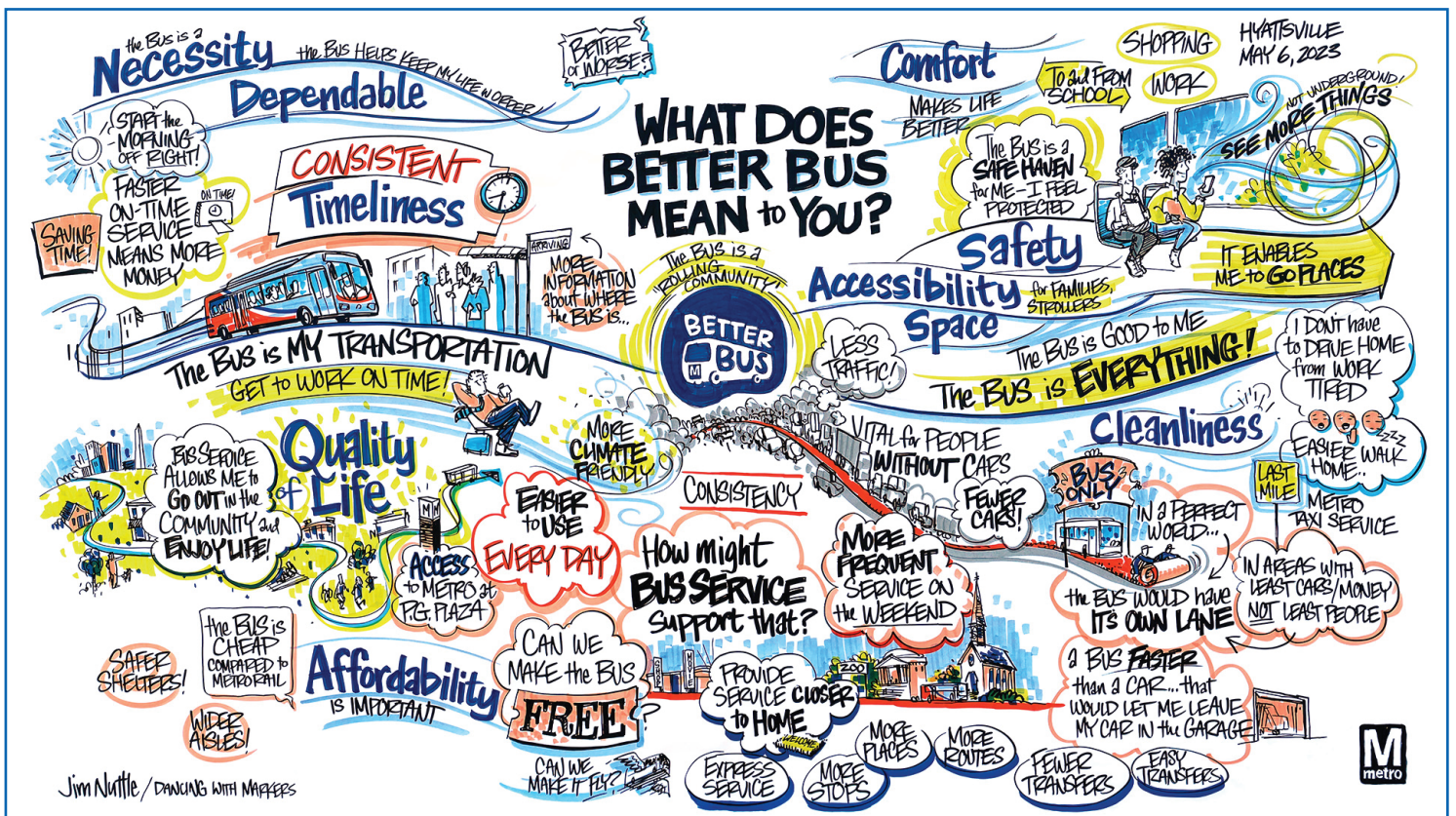

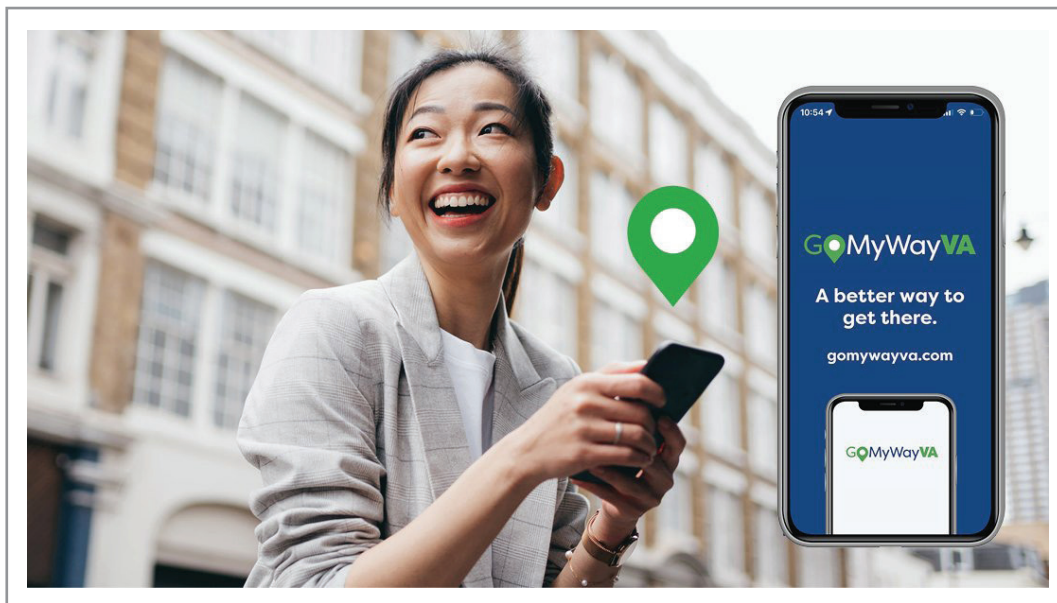


Northern Virginia, meet **GoMyWayVA** — the app designed to save you time, money and stress — all while making your travels more sustainable.
